Firearms Ordinance – Village of Caroline - July 7, 1964

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE USE OF FIREARMS IN
SPECIFIED AREAS OF SECTIONS 23 AND 14 OF THE TOWN OF GRANT

The Town Board of the Town of Grant, Shawano County, Wisconsin does hereby make the following ordinance, pursuant to law:

At any time of the year, firearms of any caliber including Pellet or BB gun shall not be discharged in the following described location:

The Northwest Quarter of Section 23 and the North ½ of the Northeast quarter of Section 23; the South ½ of the Southwest quarter and the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter in Section 14, all in the Town of Grant, Shawano County, Wisconsin, Township 26 North, Range 13 East, or Village of Caroline.

Any person using firearms in the above description, upon conviction will pay a forfeiture of \$10.00, plus costs of enforcement of this Ordinance, and upon failure of said person to pay said forfeiture and costs shall be committed to the County Jail of Shawano County for not more than 10 days. This Ordinance shall take effect upon posting as required by law.
